

What are the experiences of social work educators engaging students in critical and radical ideas?

About	This project aims to grasp a better understanding of the experiences of university educators trying to engage students with radical and critical ideas; how they go about doing this, how this impacts them, and how the university system aids or hinders this. This project seeks to fill the gap in the research of the educator experience, with the intention to gain greater understanding of the lived experiences of the educators preparing student social workers for practice in our current university climate, and to elicit conversations and change around pedagogical approaches to student engagement.
What is involved	Participants will complete an anonymous online qualitative survey on REDCap – 2 qualifying questions, 12 brief demographic question, and 15 qualitative survey questions - about their experiences as university educators engaging students in critical and radical social work.
