Participants sought	Social workers, occupational therapists, nurses, psychologists, psychiatrists, and other clinicians currently working in a mental health service, clinic, or organisation.
About	The study explores challenges and opportunities in supporting the physical health of people with mental illness in Australian mental health services. Your responses will help validate the Physical Health in Mental Health Services Questionnaire (PiMHS-Q). This research is part of Di Hu's PhD project at Griffith University (GU ref no: HREC/2026/0106), working under the supervision of Professor Amanda Wheeler, Dr Justin Chapman, Dr Victoria Stewart, and Dr Geoffrey Lau.
